What is #NotUsSC?

#NotUsSC is a South Carolina program that works to improve health for Black mothers and babies.

We share education, support, and resources for families during pregnancy and after birth.

What is the Community Materials Review Group?

This group helps review flyers, videos, social media posts, and other materials before they are shared with the public.

Reviewers help make sure materials are clear, respectful, and easy to understand.

Why is this work important?

We want our materials to reflect real people and real communities across South Carolina.

When Black mothers and families have clear information and support, mothers and babies do better. Community feedback helps us create materials families can trust.

When communities help shape the message, families are more likely to feel seen, informed, and supported.

Your voice can help make maternal health information clearer, safer, and more helpful for families across South Carolina.
